katergazomai = to carry through to the end; the end result; considerable expenditure of effort; to bear down to the ground until the work / conflict is done

Steadfastness.

hupomone = remaining under; unflinching hope; no double mindedness (1.6-8)

Is this merely the ability to endure?

Perseverance is more than endurance. It is endurance combined with absolute assurance and certainly that what we are looking for is going to happen. Perseverance means more than just hanging on, which may be only exposing our fear of letting go and falling. Hebrews 12.2, Looking steadfastly (aphorao) on Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before endured (verb, hupomeno) the cross

Perfect / complete / lacking nothing.

perfect = teleios = complete, mature, full grown, whole
complete = holokleros = intact, to retain

lacking = leipo = falling short; being destitute; being in need

How will I know if I am counting it all joy?
